#### **DANGEROUS ITEMS** allowed by **PRIOR ARRANGEMENT** with the Carrier:

- **Sporting firearms**, provided that the magazine is separated from the gun and no munitions are in the barrel. The weapon will be boarded under surveillance and will be entrusted to the crew, who will segregate the weapon onboard the aircraft;
- **Sporting ammunitions**, packed in wooden or metal crates bearing the wording "Ammunitions" and having a gross weight not exceeding 5 kg per passenger. Explosive ammunitions or incendiary projectiles are not allowed;
- **Battery powered mobility aids**; contact the Carrier to receive instructions on boarding eligibility and how to board:
- Oxygen cylinders for medical use, with a maximum gross weight of 5 kg each. Cylinders, valves and regulators (where fitted) must be protected from damage which could cause the inadvertent release of the content. LIQUID OXYGEN IS ALWAYS FORBIDDEN;
- **Portable medical electronic devices,** carried by passengers for personal use (i.e., automated external defibrillator AED, portable respirators, CPAPs, nebulizers, etc.).

# <u>LITHIUM BATTERIES</u> are **DANGEROUS GOODS. CHECK** to comply with the following <u>BOARDING</u> ISTRUCTIONS
